Charges Filed Against Driver Involved in Fatal ATV Crash that Killed Two Children

SAN BERNARDINO COUNTY, Calif. – The San Bernardino County District Attorney's Office has filed charges against Edgar Ivan Galindo Diaz (35) of Apple Valley, the alleged driver of an side-by-side off road vehicle that was involved in a July 2, 2022 fatal hit and run crash that killed two children on an ATV in Apple Valley.

On July 12, 2022 defendant Galindo Diaz turned himself into California Highway Patrol, where he was booked on two counts of felony hit and run with bail set at \$200,000.00. Galindo Diaz posted bail and was released from custody on July 13, 2022.

On July 14, 2022 our Office has filed the following felony charges against defendant Galindo Diaz;

One count of PC 192(c)(1) –Vehicular Manslaughter with Gross Negligence (victim 1) One count of VC 20001(b)(2) –Hit and Run Resulting in Death or Serious Injury (victim 1) One count of PC 192(c)(1) – Felony Vehicular Manslaughter with Gross Negligence (victim 2) One count of VC 20001(b)(2) – Hit and Run Resulting in Death or Serious Injury (victim 2)

In addition to our filing, our Office requested a bail review at arraignment, which is set for Wednesday, July 20, 2022 at 8:30am at Victorville Superior Court department V9.
